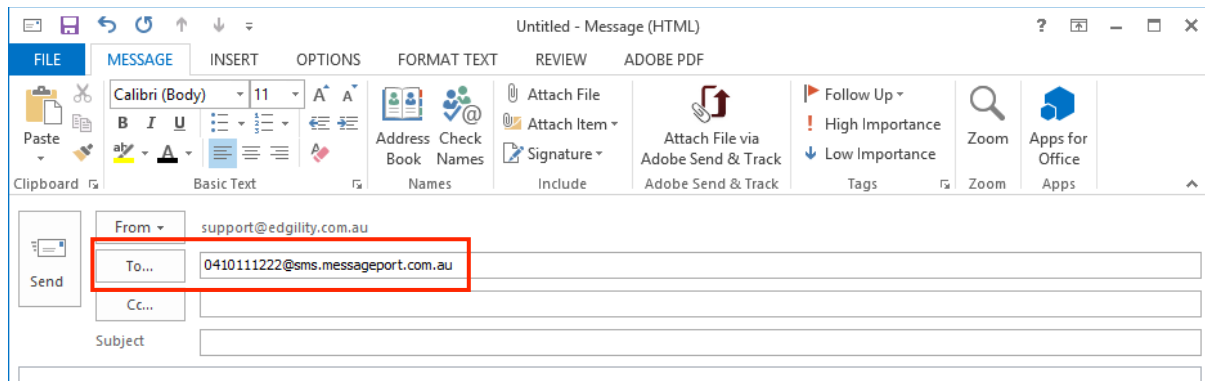


SMS for Email

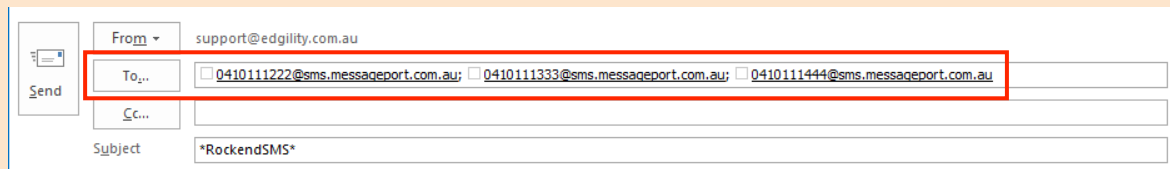
1 SENDING EMAILSMS

1. Open you email and click on **New Email**
2. In the **to:** field Simply type recipient mobile number followed by **@sms.messageport.com.au**
eg 04XXXXXXX@sms.messageport.com.au

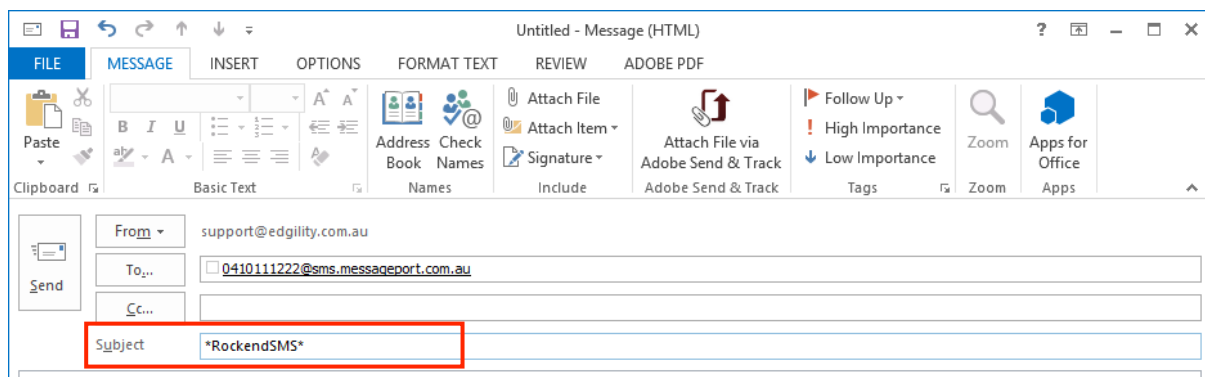


Please Note:

You can send to multiple numbers by separating with a comma or semi colon.



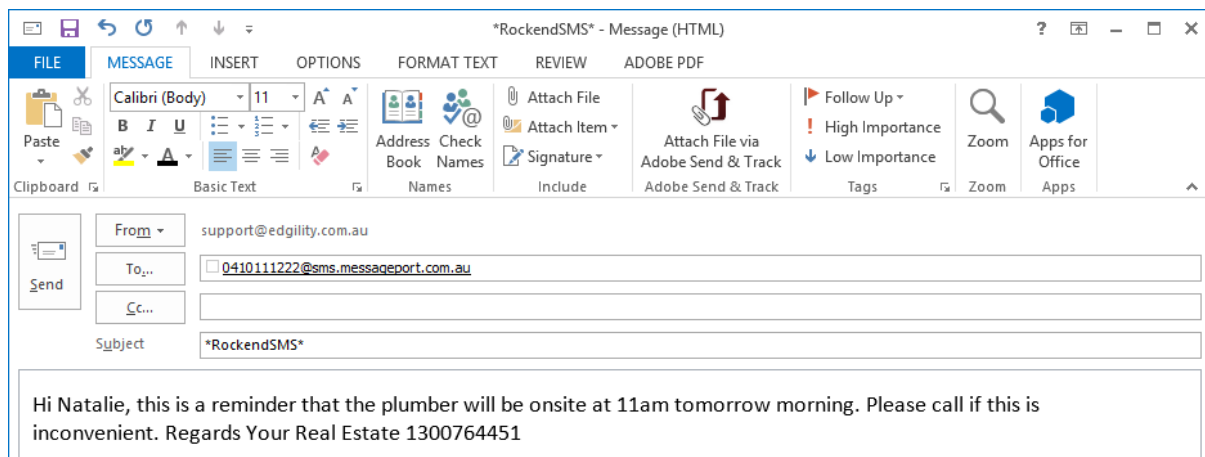
3. *Would you like replies to your SMS?* If so keep subject line blank.
Would you like to block replies to your SMS? If so, in the subject field type ***YourSenderID***
e.g ***RockendSMS***



Please Note:

Alphanumeric Sender ID's are a minimum of 4 characters and maximum of 11. Sender ID'd **cannot** contain symbols (e.g & . / , #) or spaces and may **only** contain letters and number.

4. Type your message in the email body.



Please Note:

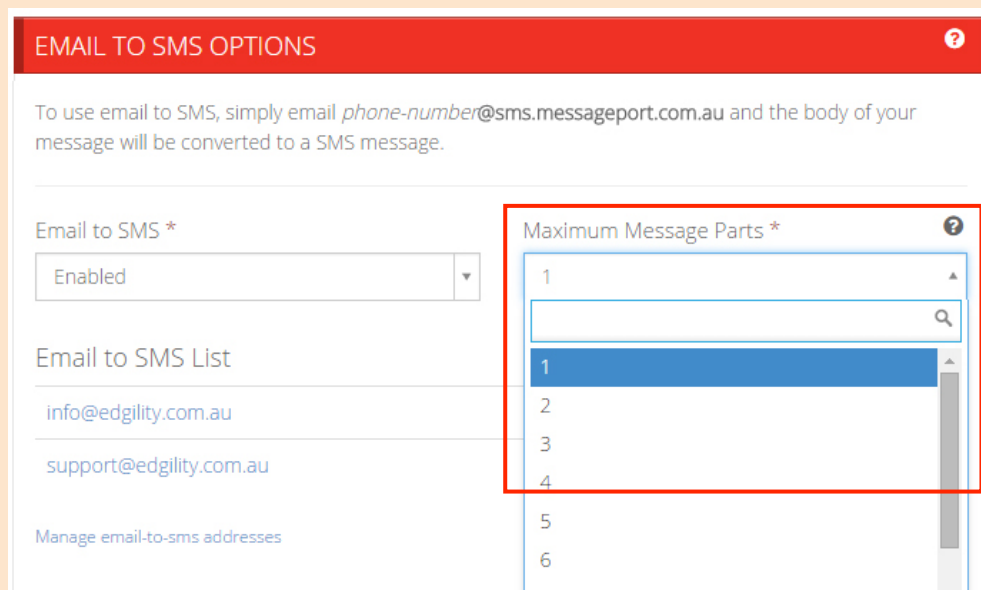
As a default your max character count is 160 including space (160 Characters = 1 SMS = 1 message part). If you exceed the 160 character count the system will cut off your SMS.

If you would like to extended this to more than 1 Message Part please login into your RockendSMS Account at www.rockendsms.com.au and go to;

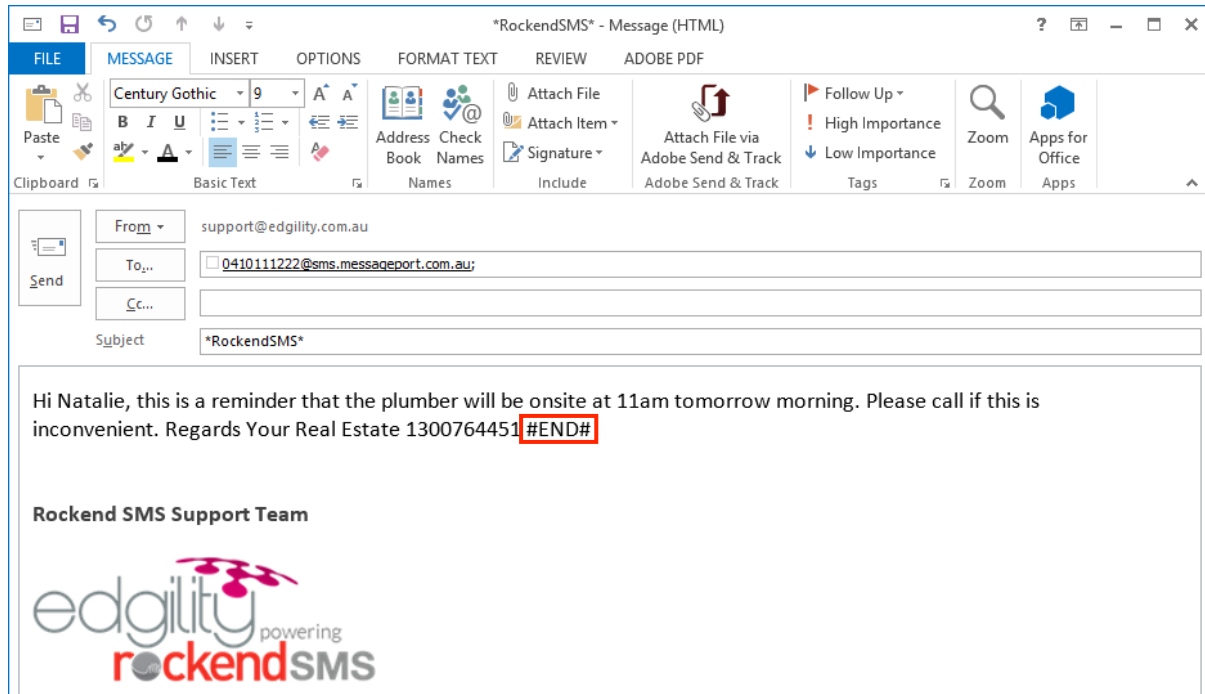
Settings > Profile & Setting

Under **Email to SMS Options** you can change the number of message parts.

Note: 1 message part = 1 SMS, 2 message part = 2 SMS and so on.



- When sending EmailSMS, please ensure that you remove any signatures / graphics / disclaimers from the message body. A quick and easy solution is to add **#END#** to the end of you message. This will automatically remove any content after this prompt without the need to manually remove.



- Once you have finished composing your message click **Send**.
